The Irish Shows Association would advise all Animal owners who have their Animals Insured to have the Insurance cover extended to cover them while showing Animals at Shows, We understand that it cost little or nothing at all depending on who you have Insurance cover with.

If you are of the few who don't have cover we would advise that you think about putting it in place for this purpose it may be well worthwhile.

The reason for us giving you this advice is to protect yourself in the event of your animal lashing out, and injuring someone or damaging someone's property, if that were to happen, and it is established that your animal was out of your control you may be held responsible, or partly responsible for any injury or damage caused and may end up paying all, or part of any settlement reached.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All entries for the Hall Section must be presented at the Show Hall, before 10.00 am on the 24th July.
- All exhibits must be the Bona Fide property of the Exhibitor.
- Prizes may be withheld in classes in which there is not sufficient competition.
- Exhibitors are hereby notified that, although every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety of all the exhibits, the Committee cannot be deemed responsible for accident of any kind which may occur. Neither will the Committee be responsible for any accident which may happen to any person attending the Show, whether as an exhibitor, official, steward, visitor or otherwise.
- The Committee shall not be responsible for any mistake in an entry form.
- A person who enters an exhibit and fails to present it shall forfeit the entry fee.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the display of their exhibits in the places allotted to them.
- Vegetables for exhibition should be cleaned.
- The decision of the Committee shall be final in all matters except the adjudication of exhibits and livestock; and in all matters of adjudication the decision of the Judges shall be final.
- The only persons who shall accompany Judges during adjudication shall be their stewards.
- The award of prizes made by a Judge and recorded in the Judge's Award Book shall be final notwithstanding any error that may be made by a steward or other official in placing a prize card on any exhibit.
- Exhibits shall not be removed before 5.00 pm on the day of the Show.
- Entries in the Livestock & Poultry Section must be received by the Hon. Secretary on or before Sunday, 17th July 2011. Hall entries taken on Show Day.
- West Cork Horse Breeders Co-op Progeny Championship 2011 confined to "paid up" members of WCHB Co-op. Each mare and foal will be judged as a unit (40% Mare and 60% Foal). Entries are confined to Mares entered in the Irish Horse Register with foal at foot with the Breed Code ISH or ID with the dam documented on the passport and must be sired by a stallion that is classified as "Approved", "Supplementary Approved" or "Preliminary Approved" in the Irish Sport Horse Studbook or a Stallion that is classified as 'Class 1' / R.I.D. in the Irish Draught Horse Studbook. The Class is also open to the progeny of Weatherby's Thoroughbred Stallions that are not classified in the I.H.R. A Mare's Passport will be inspected at both the Qualifier and at the Final. All Foals MUST be led both at the Qualifier and at the Final. Each Member may qualify UP TO TWO Mares and Foals for the Final. Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded at each Show There will be two separate classes at the Final. Entry fee to Qualifying Show €10. To Final €15.
